

I've been thinking lately of people in the Chapter who mean the most to me: of those who consistently support the FTA in leadership roles for years or even decades, of those relatively unknown and not so active who support us with generous donations, of those who maintain our trail with dedication and pride, of those who run the trail with enthusiasm and dedication to reach far beyond



normal goals, and mostly of those who have become our friends in the relatively short six years we've been involved. One whom I never spent a lot of time with but who made a meaningful impression on me was Gordon Johnson. Gordon's last complete trip around Lake "O" was a couple of years before I joined FTA and before my first involvement in it. I hiked on the Big "O" for five days the year Sandra Friend led it and fell in love with the concept. However, I stilled loved my wife more than hiking, went home for Thanksgiving and didn't get back that year.

The next year, the Chapter came close to dropping the Big "O" for lack of volunteers. Shannon and I belatedly stepped in and have continued with a hike reduced in length but continuing in the spirit of friends gathering Thanksgiving week to hike, relax and enjoy the outdoors. While Gordon has not actively involved in promoting the hike, he came each year, hiking some days and always with a bottle of chocolate wine to enhance the afternoon retreats. He also bought posters he made of the Big "O" Hikes for the first few years. Those he cherished and two years ago passed them on to Shannon with the nostalgic thought that those were important to him and to the Chapter and should be preserved.

Two years ago Gordon was substantially weakened when he came, but on the last day of the hike, he hiked in to the nearest bench at the end and personally greeted every hiker as they completed the hike. He always had words of advice and offered to have Big "O" planning sessions at his apartment here in the West Palm Beach area. He came to a few of our regular hikes, generally in JD. I remember Mary Miller saying that one on day of her hike when it was very hot that Gordon unexpectedly showed up at a road crossing with a trunk full of iced watermelons. Well, I wasn't on that hike but those who were remember it, I'm sure. For the foreseeable future, we'll be continuing to promote the Big "O" and among our cherished items will be the posters Gordon did all those years ago.
