Bridge #4 Replacement

After a number of years of continuous repairs, it's apparent that Bridge #4 must be replaced. This over 200 foot long boardwalk in Jonathan Dickinson State Park is essential to avoid knee deep water in the wet season on this section of the Ocean to Lake Hiking Trail.

The estimate for materials on the new one is \$3000.00 Jeff Andrews, the section leader for the OTLHT in JD, has started a fund raiser to help defray the cost.

The chapter is currently accepting \$5.00 "plank" donations with a goal of raising funds for the
