During the last few weeks, Scott Lunsford, Zenon Toczek, and I have made trips to DuPuis to scout out routes for one day of the Big O Hike. While I've been there before to do some trail maintenance, there's nothing like just hiking in a quiet beautiful place with time to soak in lots of mother nature's best.

In the interior portion of DuPuis, one is far enough from the roads that no traffic noise can be heard. Even airplanes passing over are so high, there's no noise and one has to watch for them to be seen. What one does hear is the occasional hoot of an owl, rustling grass when turkeys make way, some rustling and occasional cracking of brush as deer and a few wild hogs are spooked.
